THF Grants Total More Than \$1.6 Million

Edging beyond the \$1.6 million giving mark, the Texas Historical Foundation awarded two more <u>preservation grants</u> last week. The first one was to the Texas State Historical Association to assist with expanding The Handbook of Texas Women by adding more than 3,000 new articles. That project strives to promote a more inclusive and comprehensive history of Texas, recognizing the ways women have shaped the state's history.
